Entries received after the postmark date of June 4th will be charged an extra fee of \$5.00 per class in addition to regular class fees.

Starting Time: After the end of the AMHR Show (Saturday) & 8:00 a.m. (Sunday)

Arrival Time: No Arrivals Before 12:00 p.m. on 6/21/18 Without Prior Notification

**** Hardship Measuring/Inspection will take place Saturday, June 23, 2018 if needed after the end of the show. ****

- ✓ This show is accredited and conducted under the 2018 rules and regulations of the American Miniature Horse Association.
- ✓ All horses must be registered with the American Miniature Horse Association & must be measured or present a valid measurement card.
- ✓ A valid AMHA registration, youth and/or amateur numbers, and current coggins (within 1 year) for in & out-of-state horses must be provided. Out-of-state horses must also provide a current health certificate.
- ✓ This show is triple judged. Points and awards will be awarded by each judge. Ribbons will be awarded for 1st - 6th place. Championship Ribbons will be awarded for Grand Champions & Reserves, Junior & Senior Champions & Reserves & Champion of Champions.

Youth & Amateur Classes: All youth must have an AMHA Youth number to show. An application may be filled out at the Horse Show Office on the day of the show if needed. An AMHA Amateur Card is also required to participate in Amateur classes. Amateur cards are \$10.00 to AMHA members; \$50.00 to non-members. Applications are available at the Horse Show Office. Amateurs showing in Amateur/AOTE classes must be the owner of the horse or an immediate family member. **AOTE horses must not have been handled by a professional handler under any circumstance since December 31, 2017.**

Stalls: \$45.00 for the weekend (maximum 2 horses per stall). Shavings will be available on site for purchase for \$7.00 per bag. **Shavings should be pre-ordered if possible.** You may bring your own bedding. No straw is permitted. Stall cleanings are to be dumped in designated areas only. No stalls will be available before 12:00 p.m. on June 21st.

Measuring: Measuring will take place on Thursday night from 4:30-7 p.m. and then every morning an hour before the show starts. All horses must be measured. Exhibitor packets and numbers will be issued after measurement. A clear copy of your registration papers must be presented at time of measuring as well.

Office: Entries close four (4) classes prior. This includes the first class of the day which will close 30 minutes before the show starts. Please submit your entries early. While at the office, please have all your paperwork (coggins, registration papers, ID cards, etc.) ready. Judge & Show Evaluation Forms will be available in the Show Office and may be completed on a voluntary basis.

Entries: All entry forms, copies of both sides of the AMHA registration papers for each horse, lease agreements, copy of Coggins papers, copy of Amateur and/or Youth cards, copy of Veterinary Inspection for Senior Stallions, and a check/money order in payment of classes, stalls, RV fees, etc., are to be sent to Show Manager, Duane Stutzman. Checks are to be made payable to ECMHC. Entries postmarked after the pre-entry deadline will be assessed a post-entry fee of \$5.00 per open/amateur/youth class. **Any returned check will be assessed a \$35.00 fee and must be replaced with a Money Order or certified bank check within one week.** NO REFUNDS will be given on any entries or fees. Substitutions will be accepted without penalty.

Showing out of Trailer: You may compete in this event by showing out of your trailer but there is a fee of \$15/horse for each day you are showing.

PA System: It is the owner/handler/exhibitor's responsibility to be on time for classes. Announcements to the barn area are a management courtesy.

RV/Campers: Camper spots are available on the show grounds and are charged at the rate of Electric + Water: \$30/day or Electric/Water/Sewer: \$35/day. A dumping station is also available (\$5/RV).

Conduct: Cruelty, abuse or inhumane treatment of any horse in the show ring, barn, stalls or on the fairgrounds is strictly prohibited. The use of stimulants or depressants or any drug affecting the showing of a horse is forbidden.

Smoking: No smoking will be allowed in the barns, on deck in the arena or in the horse show office.
